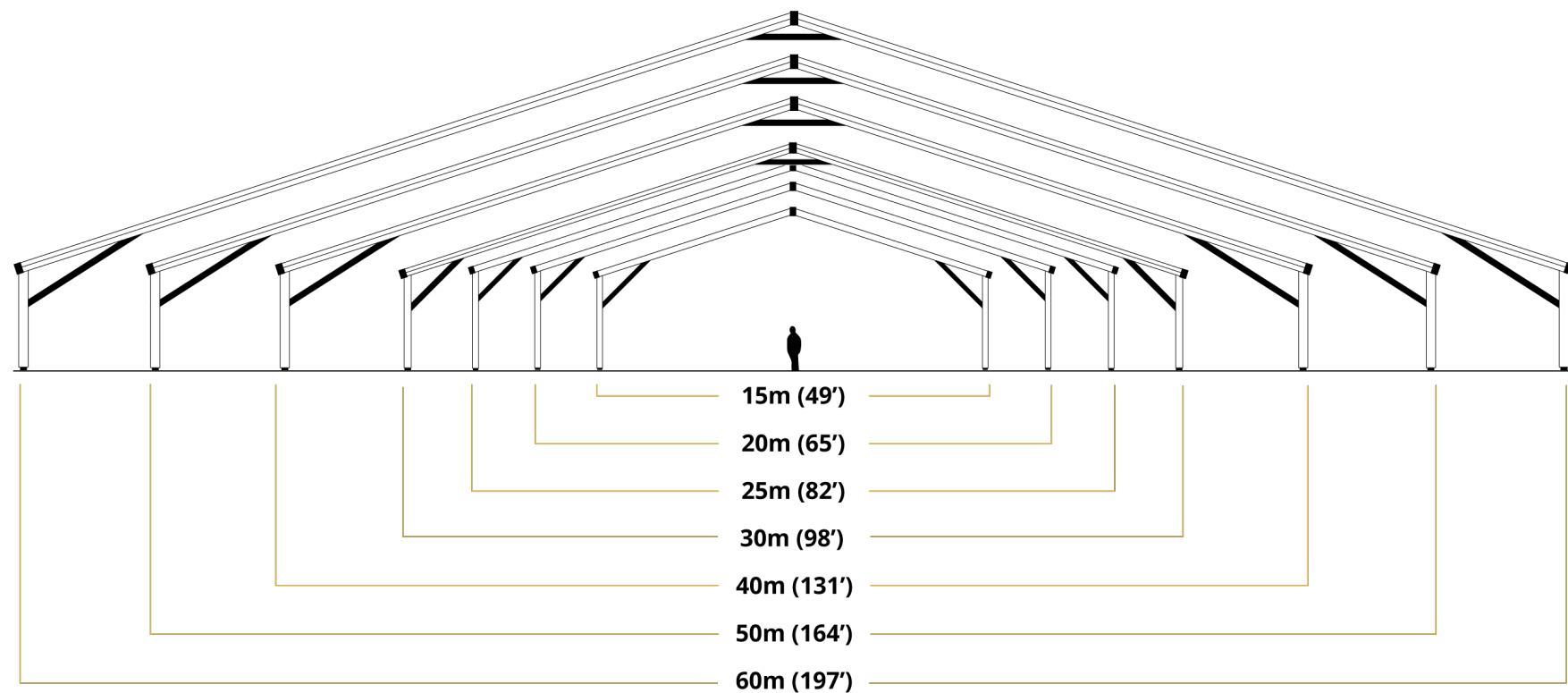


Crane Removal

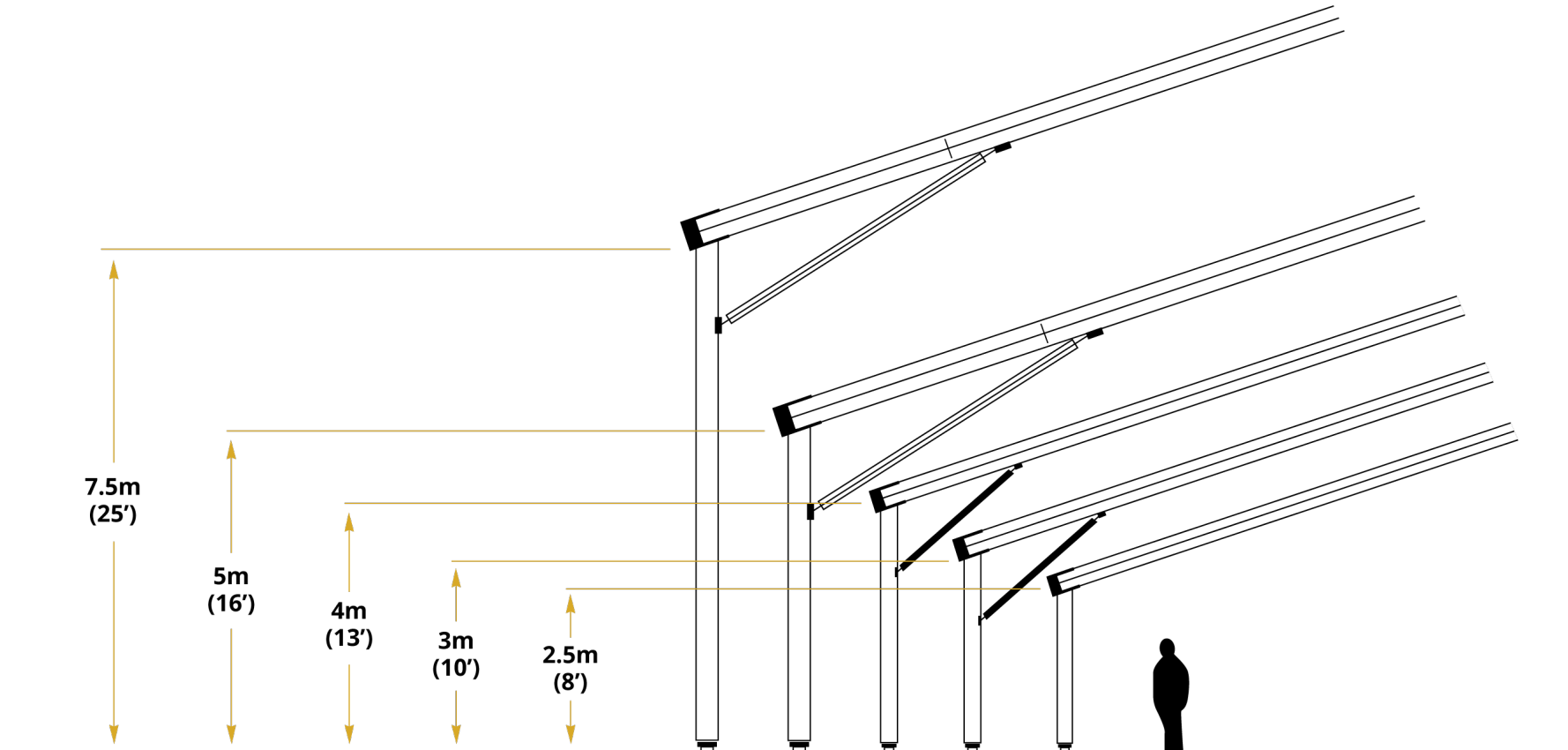
When you need to build concrete walls inside a tent, removal can become challenging with traditional methods.
